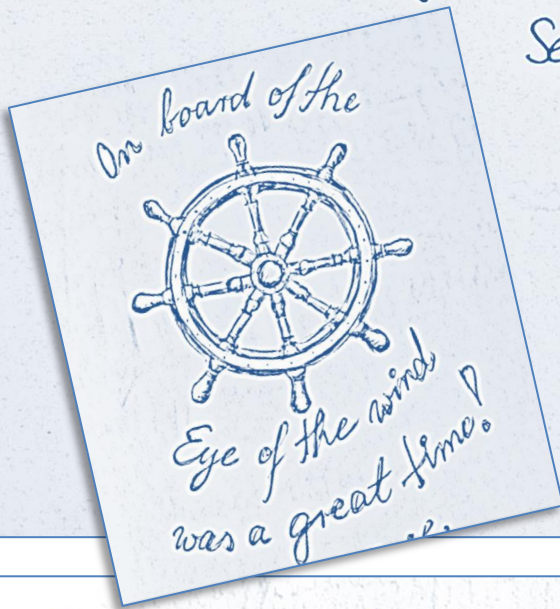

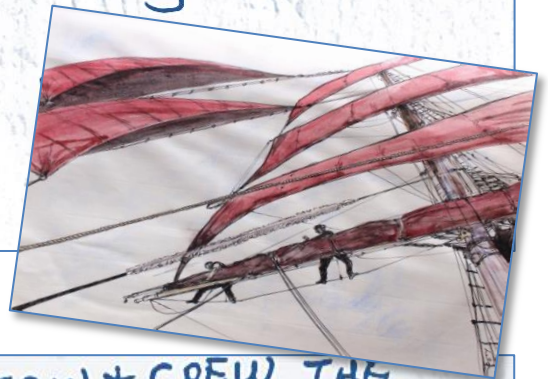
I must go down to the Seas again,
