is the way to travel.

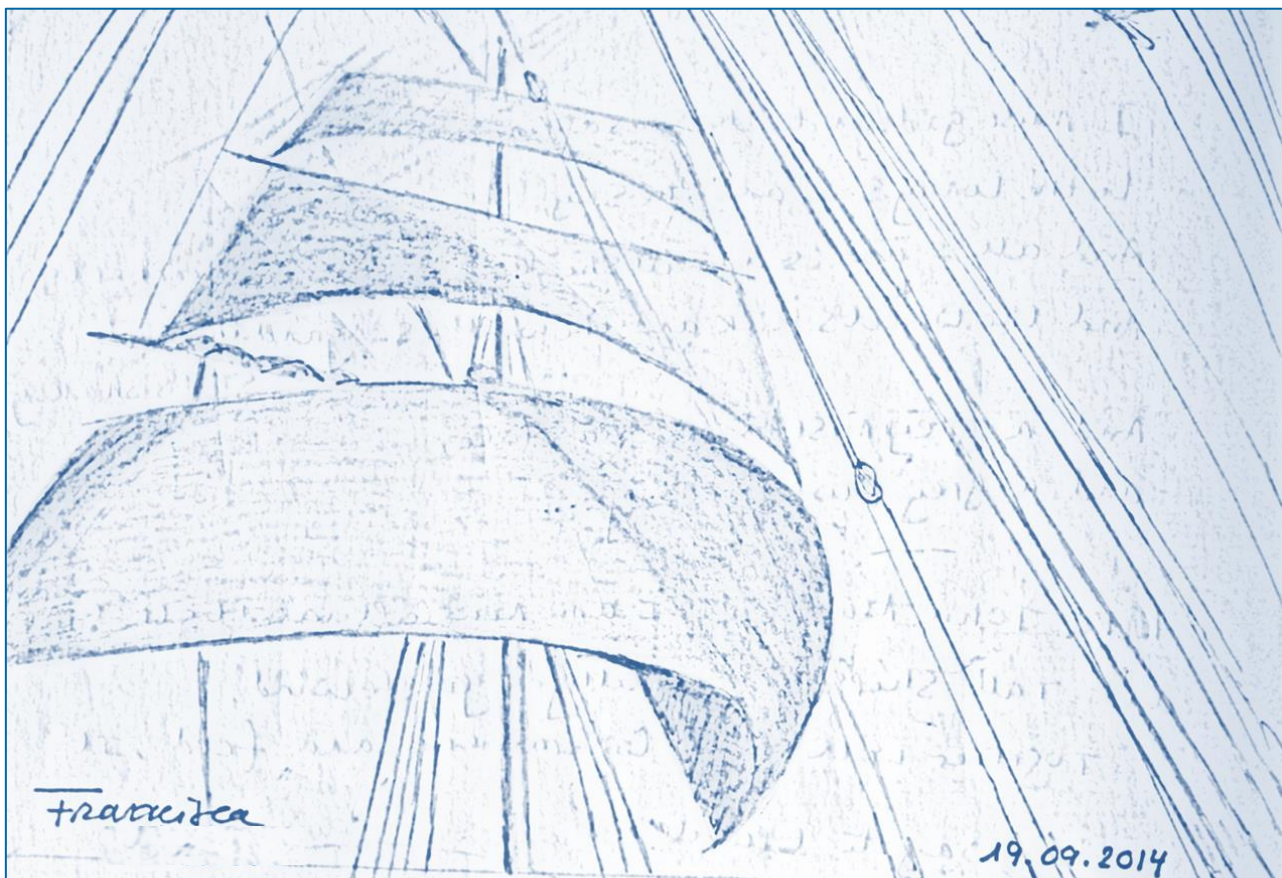

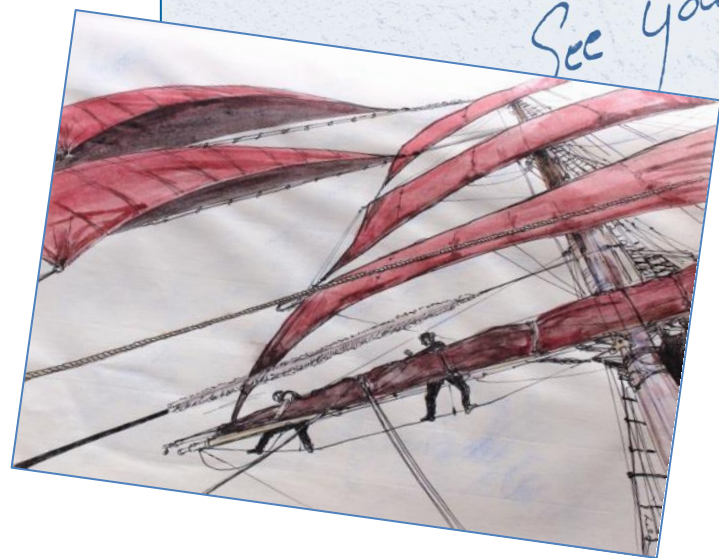
