Leaflet for fellow travelers and Answers to frequently asked questions about the Covid 19 situation

During the 2021 sailing season, we will continue to carry out all sailing trips with the necessary care and in compliance with the required regulations. To ensure that **your trip is as relaxing as possible**, we would like to inform you in this leaflet about any special features you may have to expect.

In the interest of your own health and the health of your fellow passengers and our crew, **we must ask you to undergo an Antigen test (“rapid test”) or a PCR test** (not a self-test!) before the start of your journey. **Your negative test result must not be older than three days at the start of the journey** and must be presented when you check in on board. In the event of a positive test result, you will unfortunately not be permitted to take part in the journey.

A comprehensive **hygiene and safety concept**, specially tailored to the particularities of ship operation, ensures that the applicable hygiene, distance and behavioral rules are implemented on board. Our crew will give you a briefing about details and specifications before the start of the journey. Regarding your questions about this subject, you may also contact the ship's office in advance. Furthermore, we would like to ask you to comply with the applicable regulations **when going ashore in the port** and to reduce contacts with persons outside the crew to the necessary minimum.

From the experience of numerous sailing trips we know that the **friendly interaction on board** will settle in very quickly, even under these special conditions. Should you nevertheless feel uncomfortable in a certain situation, please do not hesitate to speak to your fellow passengers or our crew in a friendly but firm manner and to point out that **the rules of hygiene and conduct must be observed**. Conversely, please also allow other fellow passengers or crew members to address you directly if a temporary situation of reduced well-being should arise. Thank you for your (mutual) understanding!

In the course of tracing infection chains, we may be required **to provide your contact details to the relevant health authorities**. We assure you that we will pass on your personal data **only on request and exclusively for this purpose**.

Despite the special accompanying circumstances, we hope that, despite all the **caution**, the **anticipation** of your forthcoming journey will prevail.
