The sight of white sail tips cresting the horizon of Falmouth Bay will herald a landmark moment in history when Falmouth, Cornwall and Royal Greenwich, London will together host one of the biggest international sailing events in solely English waters.

Join us in Falmouth

The large square-rigged vessels will be berthed at Queen's Wharf in Falmouth Docks and will be open to the public from 28th to 30th August. Smaller vessels will be berthed at Port Pendennis Marina (no public access) but can be seen from the Maritime Museum walkway and Events Square.

There will be a full programme of activities and entertainment throughout the town.

On 31st August the parade of sail will start from 11.00am with the race start planned for approximately 3.00pm. Ships will not be open to the public on this day. Falmouth Harbour offers fantastic viewing points from St Anthony on the Roseland right around to Rosemullion Head near Helford.
